**INTERNATIONAL HARVESTER COLLECTORS INC.
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The International Harvester Collectors Inc., Club will be offering two scholarships in 2008. The first prize will be \$1,000 and the second prize will be \$750 to two (2) persons who satisfy the requirements set forth below:

I.) ELIGIBILITY

- a. All applicants must be members, children of members, or grandchildren of members of the International Harvester Collectors Inc., Club.
- b. The applicants must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an accredited college, university, junior college, trade, or technical school, or other similar post-high school educational institution.
- c. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior the year the application is made.

II.) REQUIREMENTS

- a. All applicants are required to submit an essay of not less than 1,000 not more than 2,000 words. The essay shall relate to the historical significance of any aspect of the International Harvester Company. The topic shall be “The evolution of the Farmall “ (We’re thinking just the Regular.)
- b. All essays shall be submitted to the International Harvester Collectors Inc. c/o Darrell Darst, 18324 County Road 1073, Madison, MO 65263 or e-mailed to Farmall130@socket.net . To be eligible for consideration, all essays must be post marked not later than May 15th, 2008. All essays must be neatly typed.
- c. All essays shall become the property of the International Harvester Collectors Inc., Club, and each participating applicant consents to the publication of their essay, without compensation, in the official magazine, “Harvester Highlights”.
- d. Upon submission of their essay, each applicant shall include separately information regarding the educational institution the applicant will be attending. This information shall include the complete mailing address and telephone number of that educational institution’s financial aid office. Each applicant shall also include their student ID number that is on file with that institution.

- e. Each essay shall be titled and shall have a cover page upon which the title of that essay and applicant's name appears.
- f. The title of each essay shall be repeated at the top of each page of the essay; however, the applicant is not to include their name or any identification within the body of the essay itself.
- g. If any scholarship recipient has his/her scholarship award returned by the educational institution indicated in II D above, because the recipient is not enrolled in said institution, the scholarship shall be deemed forfeited.
- h. The applicant shall include separately an annotated bibliography that lists the sources of information for the essay, including books, magazine articles, websites, interviews, etc.
- i. The applicant shall include separately a cover letter stating the institution the applicant will be attending, how the scholarship will be used in achieving the student's goals, and the process by which the applicant acquired the information for the essay.

III.) SELECTION OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD RECIPIENTS

- a. The Board of Directors of the International Harvester Collectors Inc., Club shall appoint a committee to review all properly submitted essays. That committee shall be permitted to select up to two (2) of the essays and award a \$1000 Scholarship to the first place essay and a \$750 Scholarship to the second place essay.
- b. The decision of the committee shall be final.
- c. Upon the selection of each Scholarship Award Recipient, the International Harvester Collectors Inc., Club shall pay the sum of the awarded amount, directly to the educational institution that the applicant identified as required in these guidelines.
